# 1 Exporting Project Backups from StraboField

This section describes how to manually move or organize project backup files created by the StraboField app. The process differs slightly between iOS and Android devices due to differences in file system structure.

## 1.1 iOS Devices (iPad/iPhone)

On iOS, StraboField stores project backups in a folder named StraboField.

### Steps to Move Project Backups

- 1. Open the **Files** app on your iPad or iPhone.
  - Alternatively, launch it from the app via: Home o Upload, Backup & Export o View/Edit Files on Device.
- Navigate to the Browse screen in Files.
  - Tap On My iPad or On My iPhone.
  - Open the StraboField folder.
  - Inside, locate the ProjectBackups folder containing your saved projects.
- 3. To move the entire ProjectBackups folder:
  - Long press the folder and select Copy.
  - Navigate back to On My iPad (or iPhone).
  - Long press an empty area and select Paste or Move Here.
- 4. Your backup folder will now appear outside the app's file structure, making it easier to share or archive.

#### 1.2 Android Devices

On Android, the app folder is named StraboSpot2, and the backup folder structure is otherwise similar.

## Steps to Move Project Backups

- 1. Open the **My Files** or **Files by Google** app on your Android device.
- Navigate to the device's internal storage.
- 3. Open the Download/ StraboSpot2/ Backups directory.
- 4. Inside, open the ProjectBackups folder to view your backed-up projects.
- 5. To move or copy a backup:
  - · Long press on the desired backup or folder.

- Use the menu options to Move or Copy to a different location, such as a shared folder, SD card, or cloud storage.
- Note: Users may need to compress into a .zip file to share.

# Reminder:

- On iOS, the folder is named StraboField.
- On Android, the folder is named StraboSpot2.
- Both platforms store project backups inside a subfolder called ProjectBackups.
